


SYNOPSIS


A beautiful grand piano, German army guns, sheet music.

A beautiful church hidden in a village in France which can only be found after crossing a huge forest in the Perigord.


German army uniforms for soldiers (sometimes untucked / casual as they are deserters). Elegant simple clothes for our lead, Emilie.


